ABOUT TRIUMPHANT BARBARA C. MOORE



Barbara C. Moore was born on December 27, 1949, in Columbia, South Carolina. She was the youngest of three daughters of Wilhelmina and Albert Crockett. Moore grew up in a home filled with love, a sense of family, and a deep awareness of issues facing blacks. As a teenager during the 1960s she experienced the forced integration of public schools, an experience that exposed her to the many disparities that existed between African American communities.

Barbara C. Moore graduated from high school in 1968 and began undergraduate studies at Benedict College with plans to become a biologist or medical technologist. She graduated from Benedict College in 1971 with a Bachelor of Science degree in Biology.

Inspired by the community service activities of Zeta Phi Beta and especially impressed with the work of Dr. Annie Hanberry, a Benedict College graduate, retired high school principal, and sorority member, Moore joined the local graduate chapter in 1976. Although Moore had no thoughts of seeking an officer position, she was urged on by others in the organization. Sometimes leaders are encouraged to assume roles that maybe they did not initially set out to do. She was encouraged by Dr. Hanberry and Dr. Eunice Thomas. Somehow, they saw something in her that she did not see in herself. With their support Moore became South Carolina state director for Zeta Phi Beta.

Barbara C. Moore has served as Boule Chief of Protocol, Chair of the Southeastern Board, Southeastern Regional Conference Marshall, and Basileus of the Kappa Eta Zeta Chapter. Soror Moore served as Chair of the National Executive Board where she monitored an internal financial review which led to greater fiscal accountability at the national level. As National First Anti-Basileus, she was responsible for implementing a National Basilei Leadership and Undergraduate Conference on Capitol Hill, Washington, DC. She served as Chair of the National Membership Committee and as the FIPSE (Drug/Alcohol Prevention) Project Director, where she managed the first federally funded grant awarded Zeta Phi Beta Sorority, Inc.

Moore's accomplishments and hard work with the organization led her to its top office in 2002 as the 22nd International Grand Basileus of Zeta Phi Beta Sorority, Inc. The hallmark of her tenure was an international initiative she implemented known as Z-HOPE (Zetas Helping Other People Excel). The program had an impact on more than one million people nationwide and abroad. She was responsible for an innovative program initiative called the Zeta Organizational Leadership Program (ZOL) which empowers women in all aspects of their lives and certifies Zeta women to qualify for national and international leadership roles within the sorority and community. She is married to Mr. Norman Moore and is the mother of Dr. Walletha Moore Johnson, who is a Zeta.



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APPLICANT ELIGIBILITY

Purpose

To provide a \$1,500.00 scholarship to a deserving **undergraduate member(s)** of Zeta Phi Beta Sorority Incorporated that **attends a college or university in the state of South Carolina**. The undergraduate Soror must be a **sophomore, junior, or senior** pursuing an undergraduate degree from an accredited institution of higher learning.

Undergraduate Eligibility

1. The soror must be a financial and active member of a financial undergraduate chapter that is a resident of South Carolina.
2. The undergraduate soror must be a full-time student pursuing any major study. The soror will need to provide a transcript supporting her GPA and status as a full-time student in good standing.
3. The soror must have a grade point average (GPA) of 2.5 or higher.
4. The soror must submit a 300-word essay: Zeta Phi Beta Sorority, Inc. is a community conscious, action oriented organization. Give a brief biographical sketch, at least 300 words, describing how you demonstrated your leadership ability in school, work, or community.
5. The soror must submit two letters of recommendation; one letter of recommendation must be written by a member of your sponsoring Graduate chapter and the other one from your college or university.
6. The soror must complete a Community Service Form in which she describes her participation in at least three (3) ZHOPE/community service projects with her local Zeta chapter.
7. The soror must register and attend the 2024 SC State Zeta Leadership Conference.

Additional Information

1. Prior to the recipient being awarded the scholarship, the recipient must provide documentation that verifies their enrollment at their college or university.
2. The recipient will be announced at the Annual South Carolina State Leadership Conference.
3. The recipient will receive their scholarship award during the Annual South Carolina Scholarship Awards Gala.

If your college/university allows the transcripts to be emailed, please ensure that the committee receives all information by the deadline (March 15, 2024). Be sure to receive confirmation that the transcript has been sent.
- The 300-word essay must be double spaced with a 12-point Times New Roman font.
- Please complete the Community Service Form. Your Graduate Advisor must sign the form. If the applicant is the Chapter Basileus, the First Anti-Basileus or Z-HOPE Coordinator must sign the form.

Please ensure that you included all components of the application prior to submission:

- Applicant Information Form
- Transcript
- Essay
- Community Service Form
- Letters of recommendation (2)

Deadline: The application submission deadline is March 15, 2024. The online Google Form application will close at 11:59PM EST on March 15, 2024. Mailed applications must be postmarked for March 15, 2024. Emailed applications must have an email stamp of March 15, 2024. Applications postmarked or emailed after the deadline will not be considered. Applications not eligible for consideration will be returned to the sender.
